REQUEST FOR CLOSURE OF WATER SERVICE

Vermont, as a former recipient of water service from the Town of Proctor, having installed a well to meet water needs on the property, and having been advised by a representative of the Town of Proctor Water Department that the service must be terminated at the curb stop by a qualified, licensed plumber at my expense, do hereby request that the curb stop be closed, if possible, by a Town of Proctor Water Department employee without any cost or charge to me, and in consideration for the effort of the Town of Proctor Water Department to close the curb stop at no cost to me, I agree to authorize Town of Proctor Water Department employees to enter upon my property for the purpose of closing the curb stop providing entry of Town of Proctor water into my property, and I hereby promise and agree to indemnify and hold the Town of Proctor, its Water Department, agents and employees, harmless from all claims of any kind or nature, including for injury to a person, real or personal property damages, and all consequential and incidental damages that may arise to person or property, resulting from the efforts made by Town of Proctor Water Department employees to close the curb stop.
