Pittsford Recreation Area Snack Bar Expectations for the Vendor 2018

Dates the Snack Bar will be open are late April/early May – Labor Day Weekend or the end of the swim season. The swim area closes when it runs out lifeguards. Most of the lifeguards are students either, high school or college and they return back to school at various dates and sometimes in the past the Swim Area had to close before Labor Day Weekend.

Based on another vendor's experiences, the Recreation Department suggests the snack bar to be open Monday-Friday and only on the weekends during special parties or events. Daily weather conditions at the Recreation Area directly affects attendance! If it rains swim lessons could be cancelled and the swim area may be closed.

Open Snack Bar open Late April/ Early May – June – Open 6-8:15 pm

During youth baseball & softball evenings when practices and games start. There are three ball fields at the Recreation Area. Nearly all practices & games happen during weeknights. Most practices & games begin @ 6 pm. Some practices & games may be on a weekend during the season.

June – 9 am – 5 pm

Recreation Area Open House, in 2017 8 baseball & 3 softball teams were at the end of season tournament, free entrance to Swim Area that day. Many people are present at the Recreation Area.

June – August- Swim Hours are 10 am – 8 pm

Three two week swim lesson sessions, multiple day camps visit, Pittsford Rec. Day Camp is a six weeks long program. Swim Area hosts other groups. The busiest times are during swim lessons.

Prior Menu included

Pizza, French fries, cheese nachos, popcorn, hot dogs, fried dough, popsicles, candy, chips, slush, puppies, peanuts, gum, ice cream & variety of soft drinks. The Recreation Department encourages the vendor to sell healthy-choice options (fruits, bottled water and juices for example).

Vendor Fee

\$200 per year rental. Per the Recreation Committee meeting on 10/11/17. On 10/30/17 Mr. Jon Keith graciously donated his appliances to the Town of Pittsford. A red 20" x 54" portable 5 levels display rack, a red plastic 2' x 4' "Lary's Hot Dogs" folding table, a 5' tall Coke umbrella, an Open Flag on a 62" pole, a Montgomery Ward 16" x 23" microwave oven, a Hot Point 30" x 68" refrigerator with a freezer, a 26" x 34" Carvel Ice Cream floor freezer on wheels with two sliding see through doors and a Bunn Model CDS2 two auger frozen drink machine used for Slush Puppies (18" x 18" x 32"). Vendor will be responsible for replacing any of these town owned appliances with similar per-owned equipment when needed.

Vendor gets use of the 11'½" x 6' Snack Bar Area.

Use of Pittsford Town Water on site. NO HOT water at the Pittsford Recreation Area

Use of Power.

The Recreation Department will advertise vendor's snack bar business in the quarterly Town of Pittsford Newsletter & on the Town of Pittsford Website!

The Recreation Area has a natural manmade Swim Area that residents & non-residents pay to use. It also has a 18 Hole Public Disc Golf Course that is free for people to use year round, a picnic pavilion, a playground, bathrooms, tennis/pickleball courts, basketball court, soccer fields & two miles of walking trails.

The vendor will agree to operate their Snack Bar with the same mission as the Recreation Department's to provide a safe, enjoyable, family friendly atmosphere for all. To keep a watchful eye out on the Recreation Area and report to the Recreation Director with any issues. Will serve only quality and appropriate products that will be sold at fair prices so all ages to enjoy.
