MOSQUITOES

All those out and about this spring and summer should remember to take common sense precautions. Horse owners should vaccinate their horses for eastern equine encephalitis (EEE) and monitor the health of their horses. The cost of such vaccinations is quite modest. For the rest of us, we should:

- 1. Eliminate, where possible, areas of standing water (pools, tires, birdbaths, clogs in gutters, etc.) on your property.
- 2. Apply bug spray with **deet** when heading outdoors.
- 3. Wear long pants and long-sleeve shirts while outdoors.
- 4. Avoid outdoor activity at dawn and dusk.

Pittsford Alternate Representative to OCW Insect Control District Board

Pittsford is a member of the recently re-named Otter Creek Watershed Insect Control District. Each of the District's member towns are entitled to two representatives and one alternate representative on the Board, which oversees the District's activities and finances. The Town of Pittsford wishes to find a resident willing to serve as its alternate representative. Board meetings usually take place in Brandon (and remotely) monthly, with more possible during the mosquito season and fewer in the off-season.

ASSESSOR'S SPRING UPDATES

VETERANS EXEMPTION Veterans who are residents of Pittsford, with a disability of 50% or more, are entitled to a \$40,000 exemption from the assessed value of their homestead for tax purposes. Those veterans should receive a letter and an application from the Office of Veterans Affairs which should be completed, signed and returned by May 1st. If a veteran is qualified and has not received a letter, we suggest a call to the VA office at (888)666-9844 or go to the web at www.veterans.vt.gov.

HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION Once again, all resident homeowners are required to file the Homestead Exemption (HS-122) which can be found in the Vermont Tax booklet or on line at: <u>tax.vermont.gov</u> go to FORMS. Late filing will be accepted through October 15th, but a late filing penalty will apply.

UPDATES Please note that taxpayers should apply for a permit to add existing buildings from a property. Conversely, if a building is removed, please contact our office so we can adjust your assessment. Also, please register new surveys at the Town Office. With this information, the Assessor will be able to adjust your property valuation accordingly.

GRIEVANCE The dates for grievances for 2022 will be announced in June. Taxpayers for whom there has been a change in assessed value will receive a notice with this change and the dates for grievance. We will also post these dates on the Town website and in 5 public locations in Town. You may also request a grievance at any time prior to the start of grievances and we will contact you for a hearing.

ZONING Reminders—Did You Know???

Like the dandelions, warm weather brings out yard sales and lawn displays of "Stuff". It is admirable to try recycling a retired piece of furniture by free donation. However, after a week of exposure to weather and road dust; it is unlikely it will be adopted and needs disposal at the Gleason Rd. (Rutland) transfer station!

Not including the Town events that sponsor sales events, Pittsford's rules allow residents to sell their personal property on their dwelling's lawn for *up to three days at a time*, for a *maximum total of nine days a year*. "Perpetual sales" activities and regular marketing of merchandise requires a Town permit.

More than two unregistered vehicles (this includes all Trailers and R.V's) and inoperative or junk vehicles stored within sight of Town roads or neighbor's property boundaries are violations of the Town "Junk Ordinance". If you want to keep your "Stuff", fencing & screening often brings a property into compliance.

All this not only improves the visual appeal of the Town, but helps to avoid some public health issues!


Getting your To-Do list together for Spring Season? Include contacting your Zoning Administrator about permits! Permits are often required for a Change in Use of a property (such as a new or different business activity) or Installing or Constructing "an assembly of materials" over 150 sq. ft. in area. A Zoning violation can be enforced anytime, for up to 15 years. Why risk fines, legal fees, and impact your property's legal title when the ZA is available to assist with the permit process?
